## SCRIPTURE READING FOR THIS MORNING

### 2 Timothy 3

This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. 2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, 3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, 4 Traitors, heady, high-minded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; 5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. 6 For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts, 7 Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. 8 Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith. 9 But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was. 10 But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience, 11 Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of them all the Lord delivered me. 12 Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution. 13 But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived. 14 But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them; 15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. 16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

When we stop and think of the evils in this world we are thankful that God has shown and warned us of all these dangers. There is no promise in protection from them to a point that we would never suffer harm. Verse 12 above tells us that if we are trying to live godly lives things aren't going to be a bed of roses by any means. When thinking of things getting "worse and worse" as mentioned in vs. 13 one might be tempted to be fearful or get overwhelmed thinking there is no hope but God's Word on so many occasions comforts us and reassures us that if we are obedient to Him He will give us a measure of comfort and a confidence that will shake away the fears and doubts of this world. He wants His children to say boldly: "If God be for us, who can be against us?" (Rom 8:31).

## 100 Scriptures

Reviewing 100 scriptures that will serve the child of God well if they might condition them to memory.

**97.) Matt 19:9; "And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, except it be for fornication, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery."**

This passage is very plain in teaching about marriage and divorce, but man tries to make it so difficult. The context starts in vs. 3 where the Pharisees came asking, "Is it lawful for a man to put his wife away for every cause?" This question was not an honest one, but one to try and cause problems between Jesus and the people. We will not take the space here to discuss the complete conversation between Jesus and these Jews but concentrate on Jesus' teaching. This passage states that there is but one reason for the breaking of the marriage bond, allowing the innocent party to remarry. That one and only reason is unfaithfulness of one of the two joined together. It does not matter how I feel, what man's law says, or what religious leaders preach, Jesus states that "fornication" is the only reason. Some say that if the divorce and remarriage happened before their conversions then the second marriage would be legal in God's eyes. However, this cannot be, for if the relationship was adultery before conversion, then it would be the same after conversion. The guilty party could never again enter into a legal marriage relationship before God.
