SCRIPTURE READING FOR THIS MORNING

Matthew 13:18-23

Hear ye therefore the parable of the sower. 19 When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, and understandeth it not, then cometh the wicked one, and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side. 20 But he that received the seed into stony places, the same is he that heareth the word, and anon with joy receiveth it; 21 Yet hath he not root in himself, but dureth for a while: for when tribulation or persecution ariseth because of the word, by and by he is offended. 22 He also that received seed among the thorns is he that heareth the word; and the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, and he becometh unfruitful. 23 But he that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the word, and understandeth it; which also beareth fruit, and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.

We will look at some of the wisdom brought forth in the parables as they were taught by Christ. We grow eager to hear of man's wisdom. In so many ways and with so much access to untold amounts of information the teachings of God can be drowned out and seem of little or no importance. That is certainly not the case. In all reality it makes a good illustration against the barrage of information in our culture now with how we must listen for God's "still small voice" just like Elijah did in the cave. Will you listen? Will you seek to discover all the truths in God's Word He has preserved for us? This morning's look will be a good starting point on your journey to discover all that Jesus taught in the New Testament by way of parables.

100 Scriptures

Reviewing 100 scriptures that will serve the child of God well if they might condition them to memory.

98.) 1 Peter 1:23; "Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever."

In verse 22 Christians are told to have a sincere affection for their spiritual brothers. Why should we love our brethren?, common parenthood. The spiritual relationship with God is pictured here and in John 3 as a new birth. The birth is not a physical one. In Like 8:11 we see the spiritual seed which brings about this new birth, the Word of God. The physical man is corruptible; he lives for a length of time and dies. Not so with the spiritual seed, when one is born again of this seed, he can have life eternal. One is begotten by the word, when he hears, believes, and obeys it's commands. Life eternal can be his. This passage tells us that the "Word of God" "liveth" and "abideth". The term "liveth" means "is possessed with life and vigor". It is the only place where we can find this eternal life. The term "abideth" means "continues constant and unchanging". God's word does not change, what a 1st century Christian did, a 21st century Christian needs to do.
