
#### Psalm 19



### Man Arguably God's Greatest Invention

- The Creation: God Is Glorious!
  - God saved the most glorious part for last... God created us in His own image and likeness (Gen. 1:26)
  - Be amazed by God's glory in His creation, but don't forget that we are the apex of that glory! (Psalm 19:12-14) – Reflect that glory by living in His image and pursuing His likeness!

26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.


### The Invention of Man



- 1. 100 trillion cells started with one. Your body is made up of approximately 100 trillion cells. They all came from the division of one single cell. Every minute, 300 million cells die, but that's really just a small fraction of the total cells we have. We produce 300 billion new cells every day and your body is constantly repairing and rebuilding.
- 2. Your brain is an amazing super-computer. The brain is composed of 80 percent water. The brain can hold five times as much information as the *Encyclopedia Britannica*. Nerve impulses travel at 170 miles per hour. Oh, and it does all this on the same amount of power as a 10-watt light bulb.
- 3. Your heart works its heart out for you. The <u>human heart</u> pumps blood through 60,000 miles of veins and capillaries. The heart pumps 6 quarts of blood, circulating three times every minute. In one day, your blood travels a total of 12,000 miles.

- 4. Your skin is the ultimate touch screen. Each square inch of your skin includes four yards of nerve fibers, 600 pain sensors, 1300 nerve cells, 9000 nerve endings, 36 heat sensors, 75 pressure sensors, 100 sweat glands, 3 million cells, and 3 yards of blood vessels.
- 5. Your eyes alone are a study in genius. Our eyes can distinguish up to one million color surfaces and take in more information than the largest existing telescope.
- 6. The liver is a hardworking organ. Your liver works hard at over 400 functions, including detoxification, protein synthesis, and the production of biochemicals necessary for digestion. However, you could have two-thirds of your liver removed from trauma or surgery, and it would grow back to its original size in four weeks.



- 7. Take a deep breath. Your lungs have a surface area the size of a tennis court. To oxygenate blood, our lungs are filled with thousands of microscopic capillaries. The large surface area makes it easier for this to take place and to get the oxygen where it needs to go.
- 8. You have a disposable stomach lining. Your stomach gets a brand new lining every four days. Strong digestive acids quickly dissolve the mucus-like cells lining the walls of the stomach. So your body replaces them, routinely, before they are compromised.
- 9. You can't hide from your fingerprints. Just three months into a pregnancy, an unborn child already has fingerprints. At just 6 to 13 weeks of development, the distinctive whorls have already developed. Interestingly, those fingerprints will never change throughout a person's life.

- Job: God Is Powerful And Providing!
  - God's first questions: Were you there when...? Have you...? Do you know...? Job is silent! (38:4-5, 12, 16, 34-35, etc)

Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding. 5 Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or who hath stretched the line upon it?

Job 38:12 Hast thou commanded the morning since thy days; and caused the dayspring to know his place; 16 Hast thou entered into the springs of the sea? or hast thou walked in the search of the depth?

Job 38:34 Canst thou lift up thy voice to the clouds, that abundance of waters may cover thee?
35 Canst thou send lightnings, that they may go and say unto thee, Here we are?

### God's the Master Innovator

- Job: God Is Powerful And Providing!
  - God's second questions: Can you...? Job is overwhelmed by his inability to control God's "pets" (Job 40:15, 24; 41:1-5)

Job 40: <sup>15</sup> Behold now behemoth, which I made with thee; he eateth grass as an ox. Job 40:24 He taketh it with his eyes: his nose pierceth through snares.

Job 41:1 Canst thou draw out leviathan with an hook? or his tongue with a cord which thou lettest down? <sup>2</sup> Canst thou put an hook into his nose? or bore his jaw through with a thorn? <sup>3</sup> Will he make many supplications unto thee? will he speak soft words unto thee? <sup>4</sup> Will he make a covenant with thee? wilt thou take him for a servant for ever? <sup>5</sup> Wilt thou play with him as with a bird? or wilt thou bind him for thy maidens?

### God's Awesome Nature

- The Throne Room of God: The Almighty God!
  - John is given a great glimpse... He is given a tour of the palace of God –
     God's throne room (Rev. 4:1-7)
    - John uses incredible imagery... normal words don't reflect the splendor!
    - Notice how the word "AROUND" gets repeated... God's throne is in the center of everything... everything revolves around His throne
    - A timely message So much was uncertain and unraveling for these people... They
      could see the Almighty God ruling on His throne
  - In God's presence: Worship, singing, bowing, amazement
  - We live in the presence of God, but is He ruling our lives? Is God at the center?
